



# HAZARDS CAMPAIGN

**Sponsorship of the 36<sup>th</sup> Hazards Conference

As a fixture on the UK safety calendar, the Hazards Conference will see its 36<sup>th</sup> year in September this year. As in previous years, sponsorship and support is vital to run this event and reduce the overall cost for attendees.

Safety activists described the 2024 Hazards Conference as, '*highly engaging*', '*topical*', '*essential for information and networking*' and '*invaluable for safety reps to take back to the workplace*'. Nearly twenty workshops, fringe meetings and plenaries provided over 250 participants with a range of insights, knowledge and campaign ideas. The fully accessible event both in-person and online was the most diverse to date and dozens of safety-related stalls provided advice, contacts and resources for activists. The underlying theme of the weekend was Climate Change and how this was affecting the workers they represented.

For the 2025 conference we aim to build on previous support from individuals, activists, organisations, including solicitors, Trade Councils, Trade Union Works Committees, Trade Union Branches, Regions and Trade Unions nationally who sponsor the conference. Many of the conference sponsors also attend with stalls from their organisations and engage with highly motivated safety activists. The conference is a safe space where reps from more than 18 unions and other safety groups from dozens of workplaces can come together. Regular feedback tells us that networking, sharing knowledge and experience, learning new skills and discussing important and relevant issues is essential, particularly in the age of cuts, A.I. and deregulation.
