

Al and digitisation impact on the fundamental right of Occupational health and safety

Every year on 28 April all over the world, trade unions, workers, and families hold remembrance events to mark International Workers Memorial Day because work continues to kill millions globally every year, and over 50,000 in the UK, 140 a day before the pandemic arrived to make things worse.

Every year workers memorial day is held under the heading of Remember the Dead and Fight for the Living around a campaigning issue. The theme for this years workers memorial day campaign is Al and digital platforms and their impact on workers health and safety.

'Although Artificial Intelligence (AI) could be used to mitigate monotonous work, AI at work is increasing work intensification, monitoring and surveillance, generating negative impacts on mental and physical wellbeing, as workers experience the extreme pressure of constant, real-time micromanagement and automated assessment. Al IS NOT OK | Union action needed on Artificial Intelligence (Al) at work


'Rory O'Neill, advisor for the ITUC on Occupational Health and Safety Standards warns management by machine is hard at work, and it will take real union smarts to control Artificial Intelligence.'

Al includes micro management that uses in-vehicle and in-home cameras, monitoring of emails and files, webcams on work computers. Al is used to allocate tasks, track workers and negate workers' right to appropriate breaks, leading to work related stress. Al is infiltrating all our working lives and leading to unacceptable pressures through pervasive monitoring and target-setting technologies, serious injuries and ill health.

- If you know of anyone who has been killed because of work put their name on the Workers Memorial Wall https://www.tuc.org.uk/workers-memorial-wall
- ❖ If you know of a place that is can be lit up purple for the day for example Blackpool Tower, Town Halls etc, then ask the appropriate authorities.
- Ask for the town hall flag to be flown at half-mast in remembrance of those workers killed because of their work
