Accommodation

The rooms are all en-suite, have $\frac{3}{4}$ sized double beds with linen/ towels, basic toiletries provided. Lifts and stairs serve each floor and there's a shared kitchen with TV, fridge/freezer, ironing board/ iron, cooker, microwave, kettle, cutlery, crockery, sink etc.

Breakfast, lunch and evening meals are provided in the Chancellors building as part of your package. Those who have expressed a specific food and/ or access requirements on their booking form will have that information passed on to Keele University to allocate accordingly. If there's any problems make sure you speak to us at reception (Chancellors building) when you arrive. **Note:** Since 2024 Keele has been operating as a 'cashless campus'.
